Great Lakes & Natural Resources Camp is a pre-college program that is designed to provide experiential environmental education and boost campers' interest in careers in environmental science. Participants spend one week learning from experts about coastal ecology, fisheries management, limnology, wildlife, invasive species, and forestry. Youth also participate in natural resource

Youth who participate in Michigan 4-H pre-college programs are more likely to go to college: 69% of youth who participated in Great Lakes & Natural Resources camp between 2009 and 2016 enrolled in college within six months of finishing high school. That's 15% higher than the Michigan average!
